Fun things to try

Explore your voice!

This song needs lots of different ways of using our voices - slow, smooth singing, faster, funkier singing, animal noises, and using a loud speaking voice for the end.

Try singing the chorus in lots of different ways! How would these people sing it?

- a very shy young child
- a wicked witch
- the Gruffalo
- a rapper
- a really posh person
- a crowd at a football match
- your favourite singer
- another idea!

Get creative with words!

1. Can you replace these lines in the chorus...

*Raise your hands up to the sky
Singing makes you want to fly!*

...with another couple of rhyming lines that describe how good it can feel when you sing? For example, you could have:

*Dance your feet across the room
Singing makes your heart go boom!*

2. Can you write another verse describing how singing makes you feel? Here's one of the song verses:

*Chipmunk giddy, party happy,
Dancing like a disco ball,
Gibbering monkey, chicken funky,
Surfing on a guitar board!*

Get creative with pencils, crayons, paints or cut-outs!

Can you draw/paint a picture/make a collage to go with this part of the song?

*Let it rain in singing notes
Bringing a rainbow of light
Open the door to happiness
And turn the whole world bright*
